Check List for All America Swimming

Please make sure you have all of these items available <u>prior</u> to beginning an application.
Get or Renew your NISCA membership for the year. This is optional, but a membership costs \$50 and a non-member All America application costs \$30 each. Also, membership in NISCA gets you a \$1M liability insurance policy that covers you with every team and every pool. Membership applications online can take up to 24 hours to activate. Paper applications can take up to 6 weeks.
Coaches Name, address, phone number, school name, city and state.
Swimmers name AS YOU WANT IT TO APPEAR ON THE CERTIFICATE, grade, SWIMMER HOME ADDRESS (where we will mail the certificate), and phone number. You are responsible for providing the correct information.
Confirm that the time you will be entering is the swimmers' or relays' fastest time in that event for the year. To qualify, the times must be from a High School interscholastic meet not an inter-squad meet.
Have a link to the meet result available. The link provided <u>MUST GO DIRECTLY</u> to the result being used for proof of time! If a link is not available, have a paper or PDF copy of the meet results to e-mail or mail to the proper AA Chairperson (boys or girls, depending on the gender of the athlete applying).
If the time was swum at a pool that is located about 3000 feet, know the altitude of the pool location.
Know whether the time was swum in a 25 yard or 25 meter pool. DO NOT CONVERT THE TIME.
